

Dry Stack Guidelines

For your own happiness and safety, and that of others, please read this document and observe all guidelines and conditions. If in doubt, please ask a member of staff.

Booking a launch

We will be operating a launch and recovery service 7 days a week. Launch slots can be booked in advance, or with a minimum of 2 hours' notice, depending upon availability. To book a launch, call the marina office on 01305 866190. Please don't ask the yard team direct as this can lead to confusion. We do not limit the number of launches.

Arriving by car

When you arrive by car, please park in either of the main car parks.

No customer vehicles are allowed in the boatyard or near the dry stack, even when the barriers are open.

Collecting your boat

If you have a pre-booked launch, your boat will be available on the main pontoon walkway.

Returning your boat

When you return for a lift ashore, please ask the marina for a berth - this will normally be starboard-side-to.

Fuel

Dry stack annual contract customers can buy petrol and diesel at cost from the Portland Marina fuel dock. We offer a valet fuel service for boats launched on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. Book your valet fuel when you book your launch and the boat will be ready when you arrive.

Fenders and lines

If you have fenders, please leave these attached to the starboard side of the boat. Bow and stern lines should be left attached.

Bungs

Where possible, bungs will be removed and drains opened while the boat is ashore.

Boat covers, aerials and trimtabs

Boat covers must be fitted by the customer, not the yard team. Covers must be secure. Lower aerials if possible and raise trim tabs.

No access to the stack

The stack is located in a restricted area where heavy machinery is in use, so there is no customer access to the stack, or to boats on the bottom layer of the stack.

Electricity

There is no electricity supply to boats in the dry stack. This is for fire safety. Berths with electricity are available in the marina.

Working on your boat

We have work racks in the boatyard for dry stack boats. If you or a contractor need access to the boat for maintenance or any other reason, please call the office and book a lift onto a rack in the same way you'd book a launch, with minimum 2-hour notice. Electricity and water will be available for the work racks.

Dry stack place allocation

There are a variety of spaces in the stack configured for different hull shapes and boat sizes. Stack positions will be allocated depending upon the hull shape and boat size only. Boats may be moved to different positions in the stack depending upon conditions.
